- (1) EDUC 1300 is only required for First Time in College (FTIC) students at LSC. If not FTIC, students should complete SPCH 1315 to aid in degree completion at SFASU. **If student is FTIC, SPCH 1315 should be completed in the summer semester before transfer.**
- (2) Course is four hours at LSC and three hours at SFA. Additional hour counts towards elective hours at SFA.
- (3) Major Classes: Student chooses classes required for major. Student must complete the following courses to graduate: BCOM3347, BCOM4347, COM4350, BUSI 3330, BUSI3345, and BUSI3350
- (4) Major Elective Option 1 - Student chooses 3 hours from BLAW4356, BUSI4300, BUSI4385, or MGMT3373
- (5) Major Elective Option 2 - Student chooses 6 hours from the following: BUSI3310, BUSI4340, and BUSI3321

Courses are part of the Business Field of Study and are guaranteed to transfer and apply to degree programs at all Texas public institutions of higher education. Courses are not required for completion of AA degree at LSC. The listed courses will apply to the BBA at SFASU and maximize the student's transfer hours.
