SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- **Conference Proceedings Length:** Manuscripts should be between 3 to 5 pages (750-1250 words), double-spaced, excluding references, figures, and tables.
- **Manuscript Format:**
 - Use a standard academic font (e.g., Times New Roman or Arial) in 12-point size.
 - Margins should be 1-inch on all sides.
 - Pages should be numbered consecutively in the upper right-hand corner.

REFERENCE STYLE

- We accept multiple reference styles, including, but not limited to APA, MLA, Chicago, and IEEE.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- **Introduction** (0.5-1 pages)
- **Literature Review** (0.5-1 pages)
- **Methodology (if applicable)** (0.5-1 pages)
- **Results/Implications** (0.5-1 pages)
- **Conclusion** (0.5-1 pages)

*Page lengths are recommended but not required. They should serve as a guideline, if needed.

SUBMISSION FORMAT

- Submissions should be in .DOC or .DOCX format.
- Include a title page with the title of the paper, author name(s), affiliation(s), email addresses, and a brief abstract (150-250 words).
- Ensure that the main document is free of author-identifying information to facilitate blind peer review

ORIGINALITY AND PLAGIARISM

- Submitted work must be original and not published or under review elsewhere
- Authors are responsible for ensuring that their work does not contain plagiarism or infringe upon the intellectual property rights of others
