- Please wait to unpack until after auditioning

1 – 4 p.m.: Band Placement Auditions

- Lanyard name/badge required at audition
- All campers must audition for chair and band placement by 4 p.m.
- Specific audition rooms will be posted throughout the building
- Audition results will be posted in the Music Building outside the Band Hall, Room 121, Sunday evening
- Audition Music for students in grade 9 is posted on our webpage; students in grades 10 – 12 will audition with the 2023 – 24 TMEA/ATSSB All-Region etudes (please consult your band director for this).
- Unpack, set up dorm (if applicable) before/after dinner

5 – 6 p.m.: Dinner

7 – 9 p.m.: Rehearsal

- ALL campers (commuters included) must attend, bring paper/pencil
- Commuters may leave after meeting/rehearsal

General Rules and Information:

- All campers attend all classes unless ill.
- The university does not provide health and accident insurance for campers. Any professional medical attention will be at the participant's or legal guardian's expense.
- For your safety, there will be no leaving campus at any time during the week. If adults or your band director visits you, you will need permission from the head counselor to leave the dorm with them and only on your free time. To leave campus, please bring a written note signed by a parent/guardian approving the off-campus activity.
- SFA classes are in session. Campers should not interact with SFA students.
- There will be no alcoholic beverages or unlawful substances permitted at camp. If there is any indication of a camper's indulgence in alcohol or unlawful substances during the camp, the student's parents will be notified immediately to come for them, and the student will be dismissed from the camp.
- Fighting, vandalism and other serious disobedience of camp rules may be grounds for expulsion. Parents of violators will be notified immediately to come for them, and the student will be dismissed from camp.

Activities and Recreation

- Swimming, sports and other planned activities in the evenings

Refunds:

All campers are expected to participate in the entire camp.

There will be no partial refunds given.

Fees:

If driving yourself, a \$5/day parking pass **MUST** be purchased at registration!

Cash or check only!

As per SFA safety policy: In the event of a lost key, a \$75 fee will be assessed to the camper for re-coring the lock.

Please keep up with your dorm key!

What to Bring to Camp:

- Instrument, reeds, sticks/mallets and any other necessary accessories
- Modest, hot-weather, casual clothes
- Clothes for concert on Friday (Sunday best)
- A light jacket because the buildings can get cool during classes
- Water bottle or thermos
- Hat – spending some time outside during the day
- Comfortable shoes
- Twin-size bed sheets, pillow with case, blankets because the dorms get cool
- Toiletries
- Towel (community bathrooms)
- Medical needs – medication, etc.
