- Whereas:** The Student Government Association (SGA) is an organization for the students, by the students, dedicated to the traditions of Stephen F. Austin State University (SFASU) and upholding The SFA Way;
- Whereas:** One of the five principles of The SFA Way is caring, that is, for the students, for the school of SFASU, and the legacy of excellence left for future Lumberjacks;
- Whereas:** The bylaws of SGA (Article IV, Section 13), state it is the responsibility of SGA to “provide assistance in collecting, organizing, and preserving materials of historical significance;”
- Whereas:** No current plans are in place to create a permanent record of the specific events, experiences, and memories of SGA other than the digital record available on social media, which is not a viable platform for longevity as social media changes constantly and was not created to be a historical record;
- Enacted:** SGA shall allocate \$100 for the creation of a scrapbook detailing the unique legislation, events, and experiences of SGA.
- Further Enacted:** The scrapbook shall be available in the SGA office for any student to view, giving students a visual for SGA’s initiatives.
- Further Enacted:** Any unused funds shall be returned to the SGA budget.
